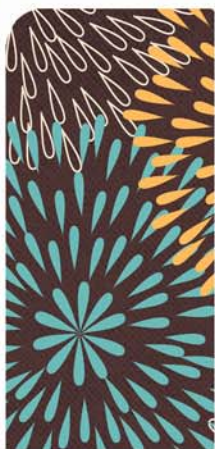


Mixed Media Materials List



Mixed Media Material List

Here I have provided a list of items you will need to bring to class (and my tried and tested preferred products*) and a list of items that will be included in your class kit.

Please bring to class:

- All the paint brushes you have. I use foam ones and "Royal Langnickel" from Spotlight.
- As many acrylic paints as you can find.
- An art journal... a book with blank pages to draw and paint in.
- Gesso (white and/or transparent), just a small tub - I use Mattise
- Golden Gel Medium (Regular Gel (Semi-Gloss)) is the one I use and it works brilliantly. Otherwise you could get Matisse "Polymer Gloss Varnish".
- Any stamps you may have already.
- Scraps of patterned papers
- Emphoria - old postcards, envelopes, notes you've been holding onto
- Images from magazines that appeal to you... tear the whole page out & bring it
- Household items: meat trays, bubble wrap, glad wrap, CLEAR packing tape, plumbers tape (white with little grid), paper towels, serviettes with patterns or pictures, chocolate wrappers (foil) . This is an "ideas" list, just grab any of these items you may have at home (or anything else you think of) - put them aside into a box or envelope, ready for our first class.

Your kit will contain (this is a \$100 kit you pay for at your first class):*

- 1 tub of polished pigment by LuminArte
- 1 tub of Twinkling H₂O by LuminArte
- 1 2oz bottle of Glimmer Mist by Tattered Angels
- 1 x foam alphabet stamp set
- 1 x chipboard alphabet set
- 1 x 2.5 oz tube of acrylic paint
- 2 x sets of stickers
- 1 x mini mask
- * 1 x set of rub ons
- * 1 x A3 sheet of 300gsm Fabriano Watercolour Paper
- 2 x canvas (1 mini, 1 medium)
- 4 x (12" x10") pine wood board
- some fabric swatches
- various patterned papers
- 800 inspiring quotes
- images for transferring
- A hardcovered book - stitch bound book.
- items for creating your own stamps (rubber, light and dense foams)
- variety of collage items (text pages, tissue papers, serviettes, old patterns)
- vintage book pages and sheet music
- a plastic bound folder to keep all your class notes and handouts organised
- a CD with images and reference material



* you do NOT have to buy this kit, but you DO NEED ALL OF THESE PRODUCTS for the class and to learn the techniques I am teaching. You will find that this is a very cost effective kit.
